In view of the class suspension after the Chinese New Year holidays, the Information Session of iEnrichment scheduled on **11 February 2020 (Tuesday), 4:45pm - 5:45pm** will be **CANCELLED**. Programme Details

CEDARS Global Career Springboard Scheme (CGCSS) aims at enriching students' global exposure by offering International Internships, Career Exploration Programmes and other career learning experience in locations outside Hong Kong. Eligible students who have successfully completed one activity under CGCSS may earn one credit from the Credit Award Scheme for Out-of-classroom Learning Experiences.

iEnrichment (<https://ienrichment.org/>) is inviting applications for its **International Internship and Cultural Experimental Programme 2020 in Spain, Russia and Turkey**.

iEnrichment is an organisation with an aim to promote education, culture, professional and youth development through a practical international internship, innovative research, and cultural experiential activities. They work with leading companies, NGOs and universities at a variety of internship destinations.

The programme fee includes internship placement, accommodation, airport transfer, cultural activities and language classes.

* **Early Bird Special:** A discount of HK\$2,000 will be given to students who submitted application, completed the interviews and paid the deposit before 31 March 2020.

Application Method

Please follow the below **2 steps** to submit your application:

Step 1:

(*All interested students, including those who had registered for a CGCSS account in 2018-19, are required to register for a new account in 2019-20 year)

For Research Placements, students should indicate your preferred research scope and areas with not less than 30 words in your email application.

For Professional Placements, students should indicate your preferred travel distance to work and flexibility to work at a co-working space.

Shortlisted students will be invited for an interview with the Consultants of iEnrichment within 3 business days.

Application Deadlines

Early Bird Deadline : 31 March 2020 (Tuesday)
Final Deadline : Extended to 30 April 2020 (Thursday)

Attention

- ❖ Students have to thoroughly review and understand the entire process of application, interview/screening, job matching, offer and payment stages. Students are required to pay a deposit and refund is not allowed if you withdraw from the programme once you are accepted by the employers.
- ❖ This is a self-financed programme. There is no sponsorship or allowance from CEDARS. Interns are responsible for their own arrangement, including but not limited to air tickets, transportation, insurance, daily expenses etc. Students are reminded to consider carefully your study plan, the job nature, organisation culture, accommodation arrangement, your availability for the whole internship and financial situation etc. before making the application.
- ❖ Working hours are subject to changes upon requirement from the employers according to their seasonal and manpower needs.
- ❖ Students are recommended to research on the visa application matters and eligibility in relation to their passport and the internship location before they apply

for the internship. Applicants must be aged 18 or above when submit the applications.

- ❖ Insurance: It is a compulsory requirement that students are appropriately/sufficiently insured for the whole internship period. Students have to consider the living environment and safety issues in the placement locations.

Credit Award Scheme for Out-of-classroom Learning Experiences

CGCSS is one of the pre-approved programmes under the Credit Award Scheme for Out-of-classroom Learning Experiences. Non-final year undergraduate students who have successfully completed one activity under CGCSS may be eligible to earn one credit from the Scheme by submitting an endorsement granted by CEDARS and application to HKU Horizons Office for formal approval before end of August 2020. The credits are academic credits, but will not contribute to the University's degree requirements. Credits can be accumulated one at a time, but students are only able to claim actual, transcriptable credits in blocks of three, as no course should have a credit value of less than three credits under the University's undergraduate curriculum structure.
